The 10 days visit is part of the Youth exchange project "Art - our common language". We applied as partners of this project and during the visit in Macedonia our members will meet around 40 new people from 6 other countries - Albania, Macedonia, Poland, Portugal, Serbia and Turkey. They will spend two weeks at the most famous place in Macedonia - Ohrid lake, where they will take part in different workshops about dance, theatre and singing. Also they will visit some historical places and some cities. We hope that it will be the experience which they will remember for a long time.

This project like many other projects is financed by YOUTH program and all the expenses are paid by The European Union. (the participants pay only 30% of the travel cost). We believe those kind of experiences are the best way for the young people from Europe to learn more about each other and their countries. So we're trying

to apply for more projects and give opportunity to more youngsters from Velky Meder to go abroad. So far till the end of 2006 we hope that we will have other two exchange projects, which we're applying for now.
